CURRENT POLICY IS TO RELEASE DATA WITHOUT PERSONAL IDENTIFIERS



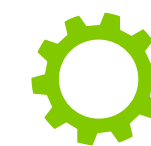
DATA SHARING REQUIRED BY STATUTE

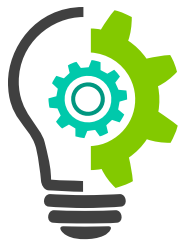
GUIDELINES WORKSHEETS
