

# **Possible Topics for Guidelines Revisions**

Examples:

- Conspiracy to steal property with aggregate value over \$200 (§ 18.2-23(B))
- Larceny with intent to sell or distribute property (§ 18.2-108.01)
  - Property valued at \$200 or more
  - Property with aggregate value of \$200 or more
- Aggravated sexual battery, parent/grandparent with child age 13 to 17 (§ 18.2-67.3(A,3))

## Examining New Crimes as Possible Additions to List of Violent Offenses in § 17.1-805

**Examples:** 

- Strangulation (§ 18.2-51.6)
- Show child pornography or grooming video to a child (§ 18.2-374.4)
- Use force or threats to encourage membership in street gang (§ 18.2-46.3)
- Unlawfully kill the fetus of another (§ 18.2-32.2)

- Cases involving burglary of a non-dwelling and multiple counts of grand larceny
  - Under guidelines rules, larceny is the primary offense
  - Scoring larceny as the primary offense returns a lower recommendation than if burglary were scored as the primary offense

- Cases involving burglary with a weapon and malicious wounding
  - Under guidelines rules, burglary with a weapon is the primary offense
  - Scoring burglary as the primary offense returns a lower recommendation than if malicious wounding were scored as the primary offense

 Cases involving involuntary vehicular manslaughter (§ 18.2-36.1)

- Compliance for this offense is lower than the overall compliance rate and there is higher aggravation rate (32%)
- Cases involving multiple counts of certain drug offenses
  - In some circumstances, having multiple counts does not increase the guidelines recommendation

- Cases involving certain drug offenders with prior convictions for possession or distribution, etc., of a Schedule I or II drug
  - The factor on the guidelines for scoring prior drug convictions does not currently capture prior convictions for delivering a Schedule I or II drug to an inmate (§ 18.2-474.1)

SCORE THE FOLLOWING FACTOR ONLY IF PRIMARY OFFENSE IS POSSESSION OF SCHEDULE I/II DRUG (§ 18.2-250(A,a))

Two or More Prior Felony Convictions/Adjudications	— If YES, add 2
For Possession, Possession with Intent, Distribution, Manufacture or Sale of Schedule I or II Drug	

- Proposals will reflect the best fit for the historical data
- Proposals will be designed to closely match the historical rate of incarceration in prison and jail
- Current guidelines worksheets serve as the base for scoring historical cases, but the points assigned to those factors may be adjusted and new factors may be added
