



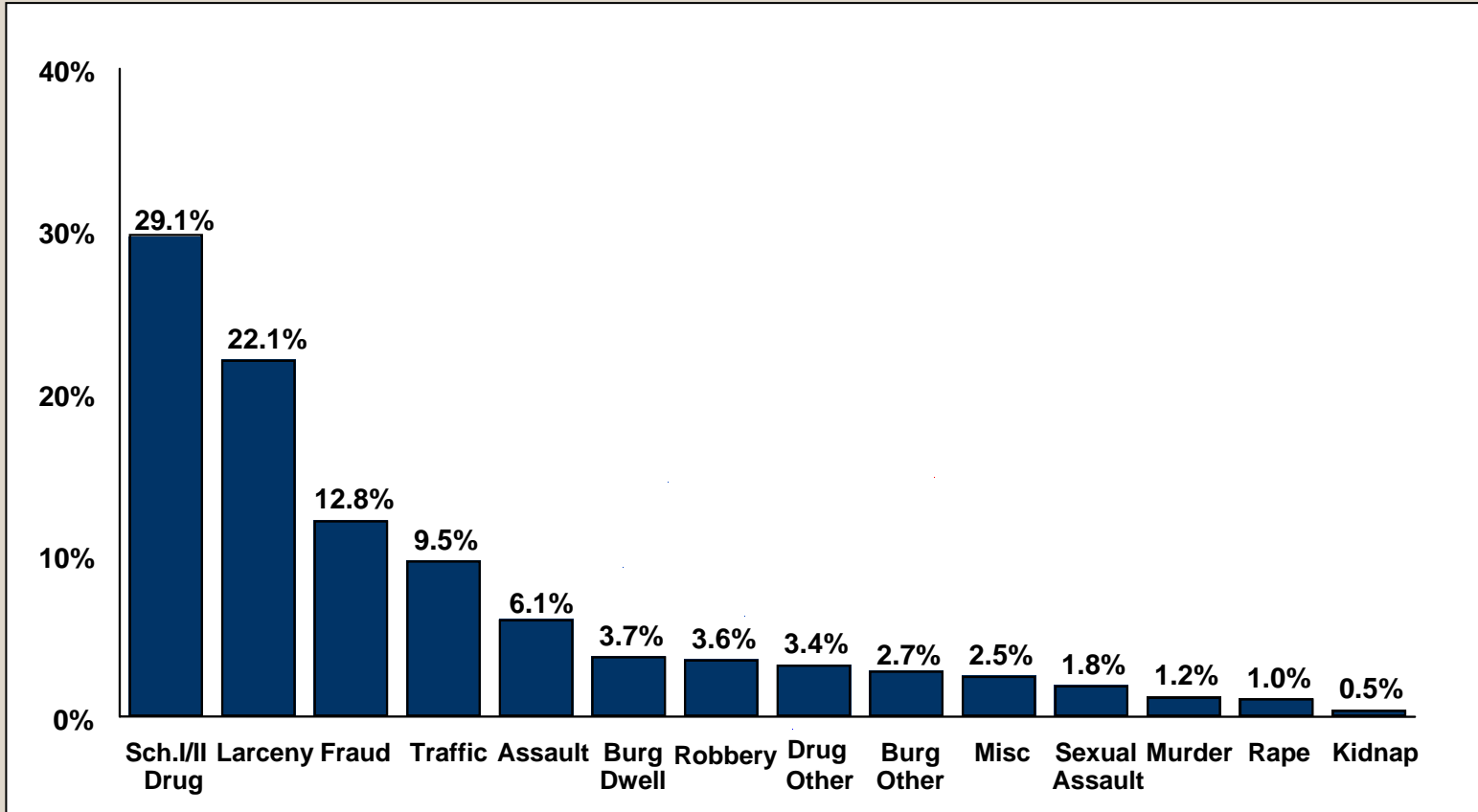

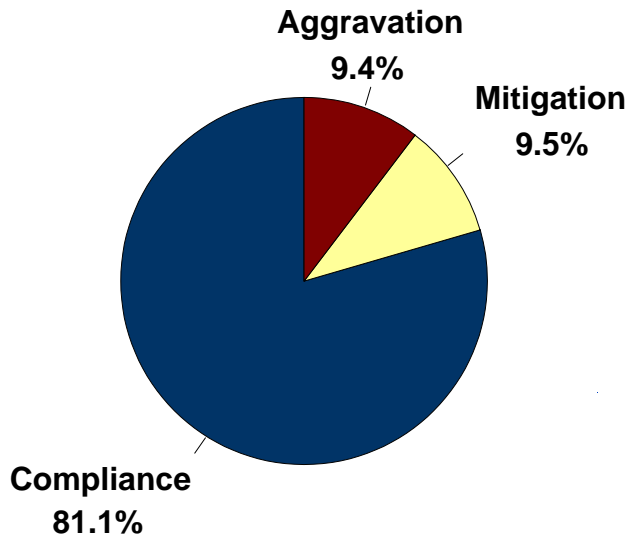

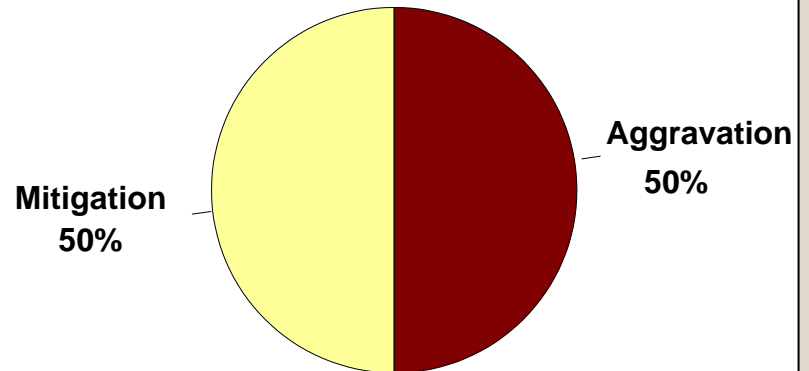

### Overall Compliance



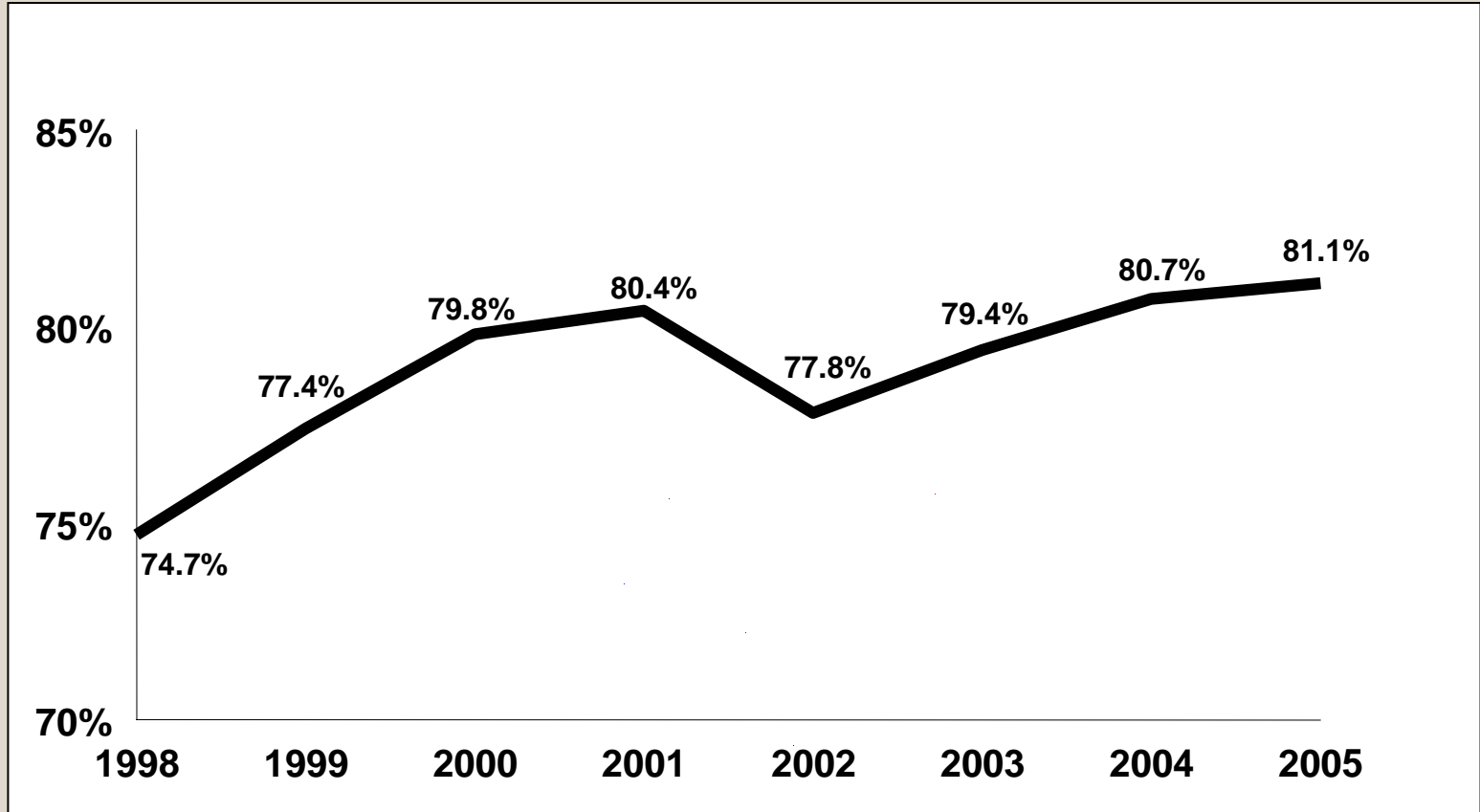

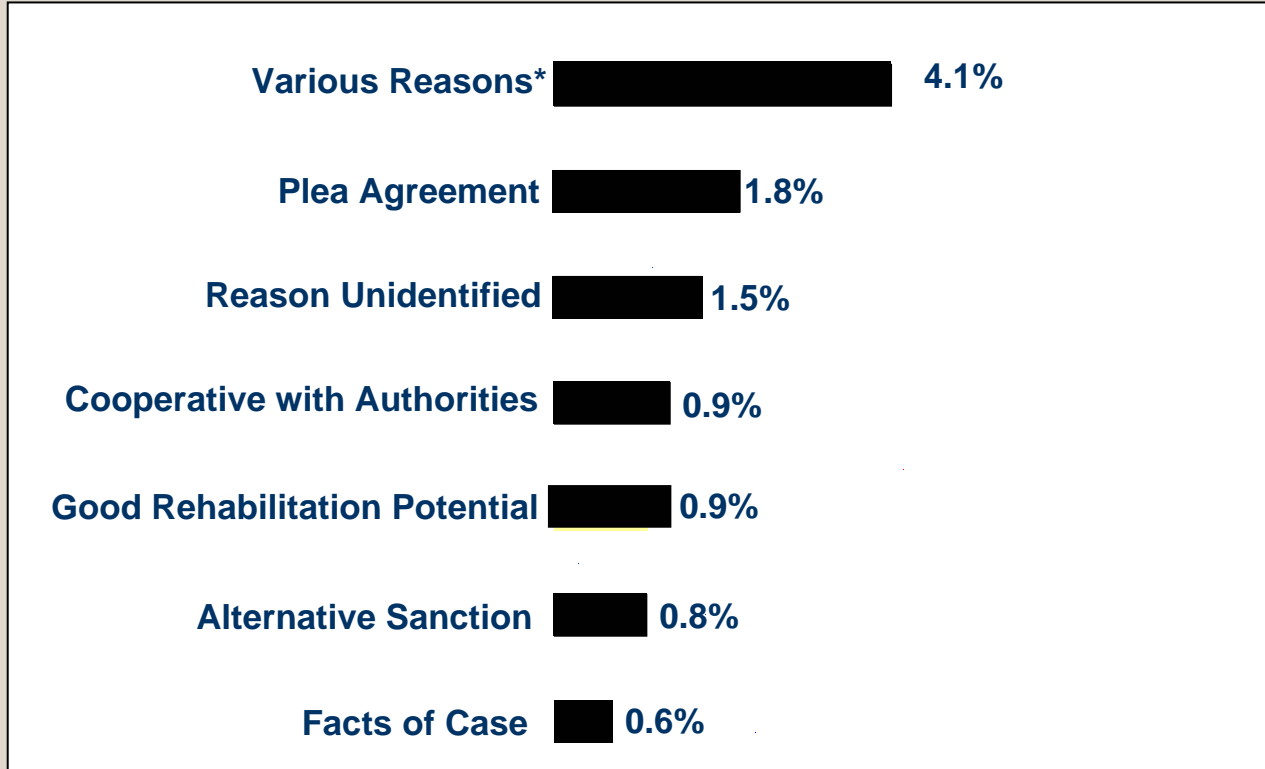

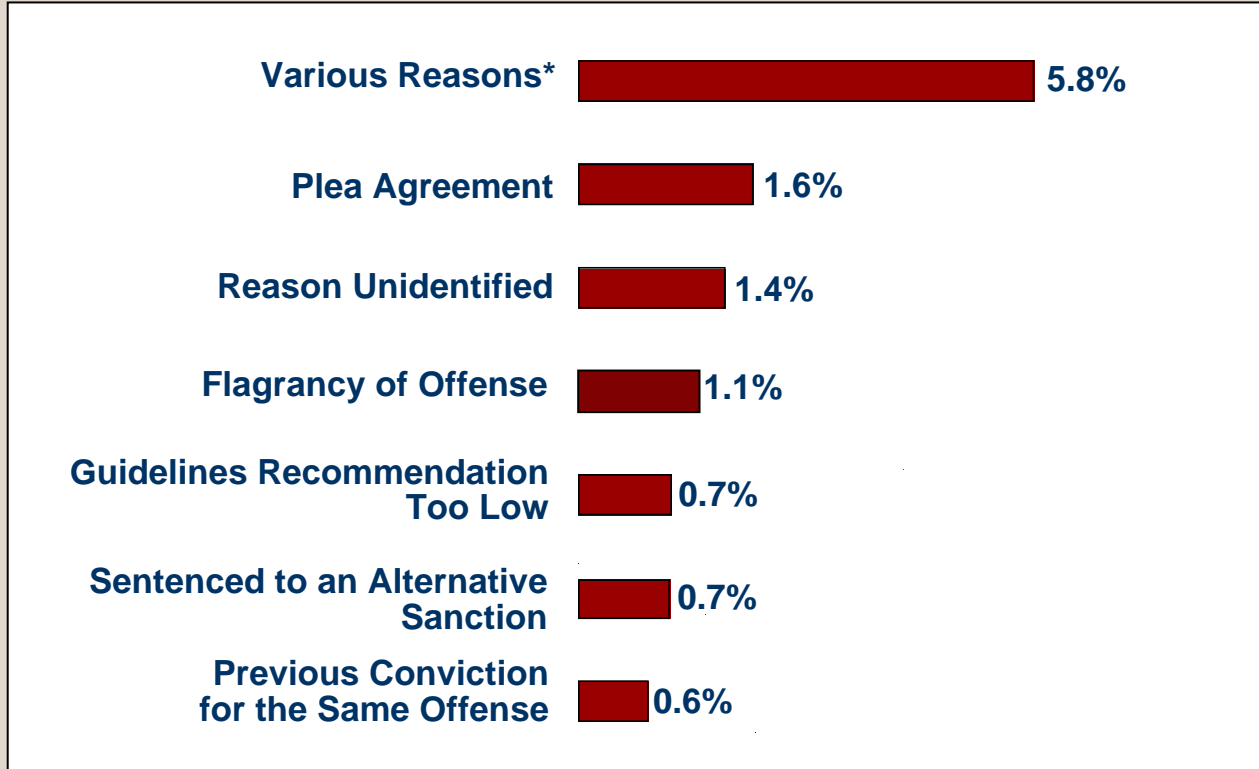
# Most Common Reasons for Departure - Mitigation

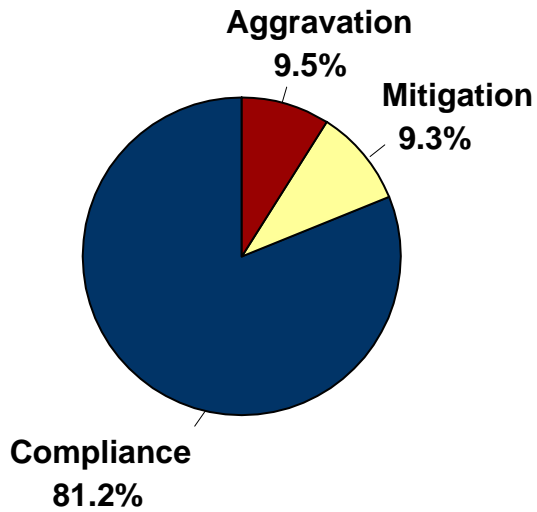

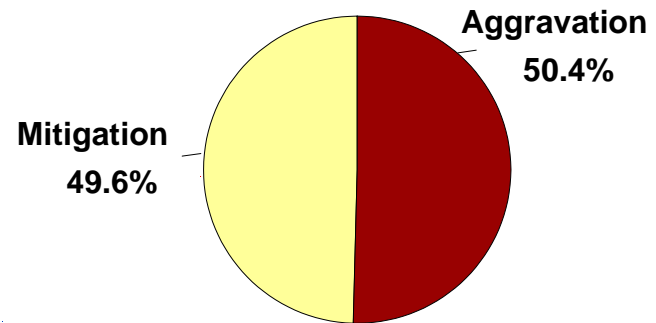

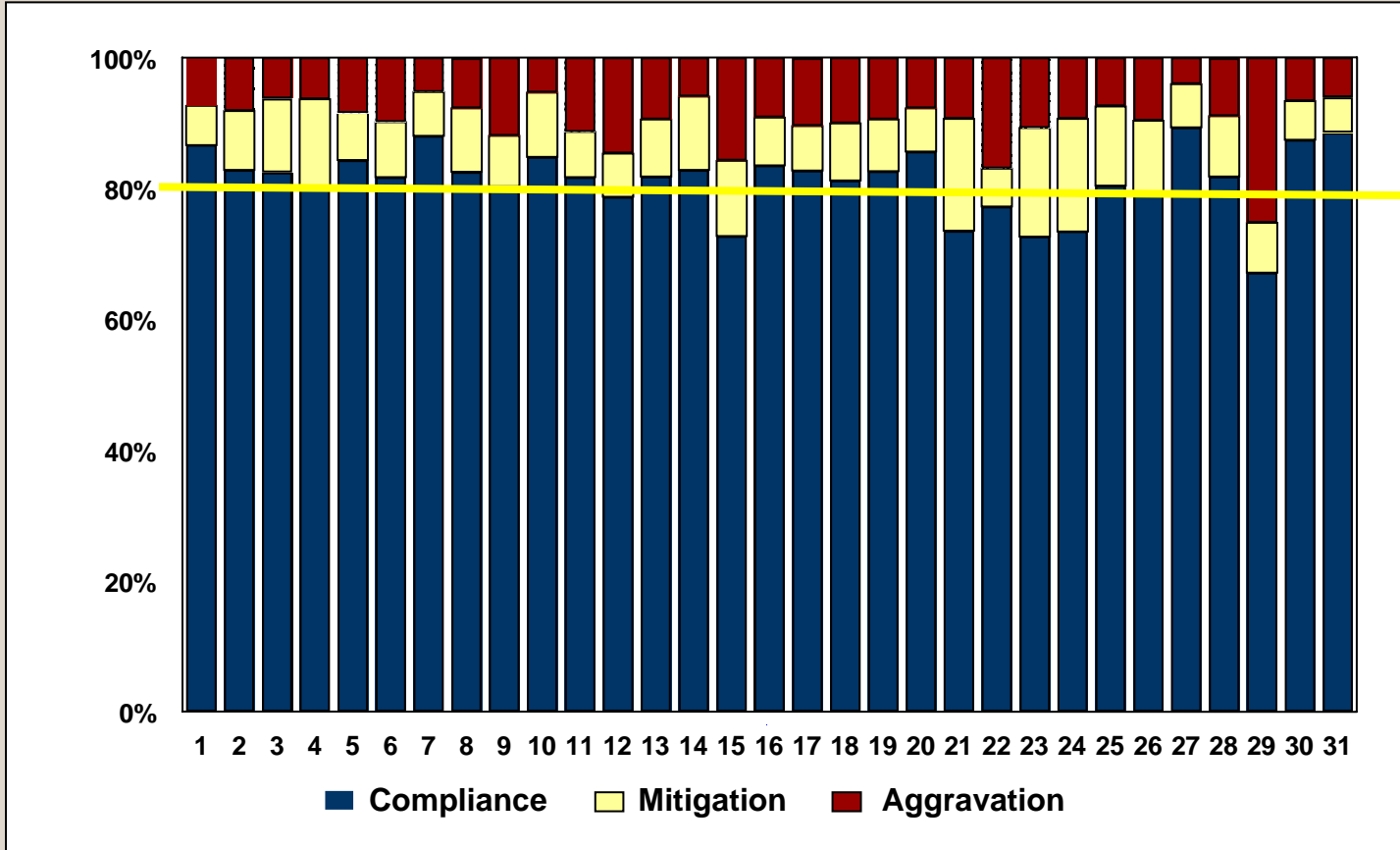


### Directions of Departures





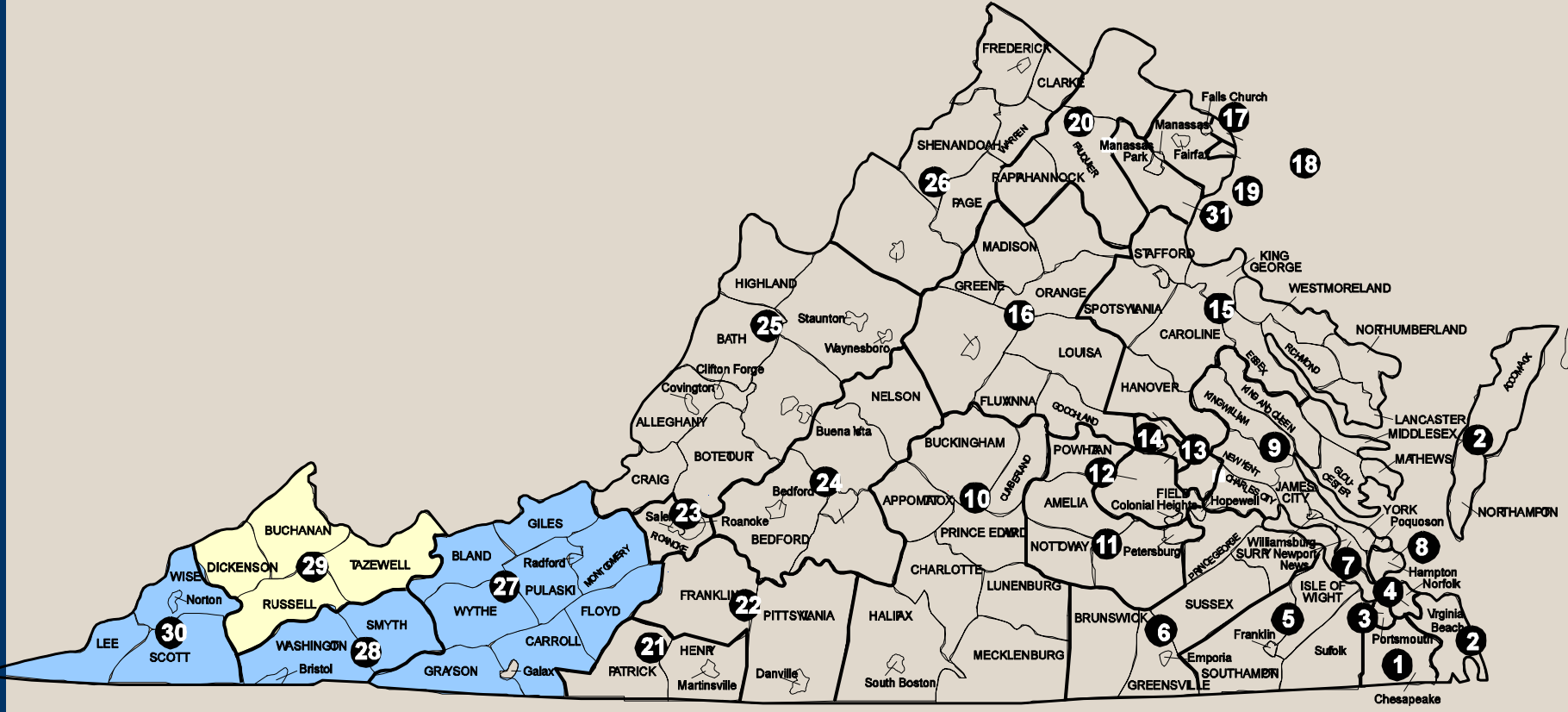
# Guidelines Compliance by Circuit

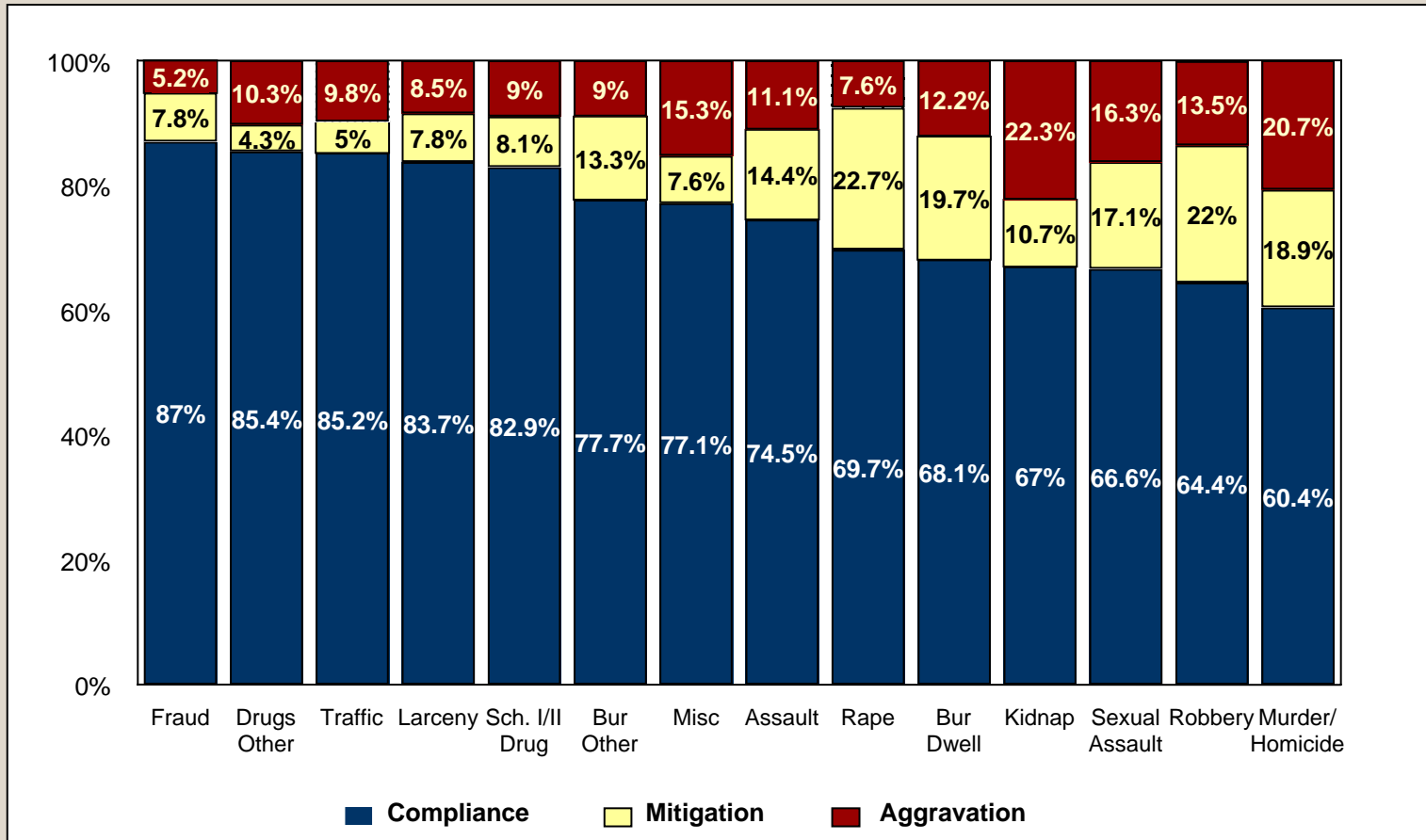
# Judicial Circuits

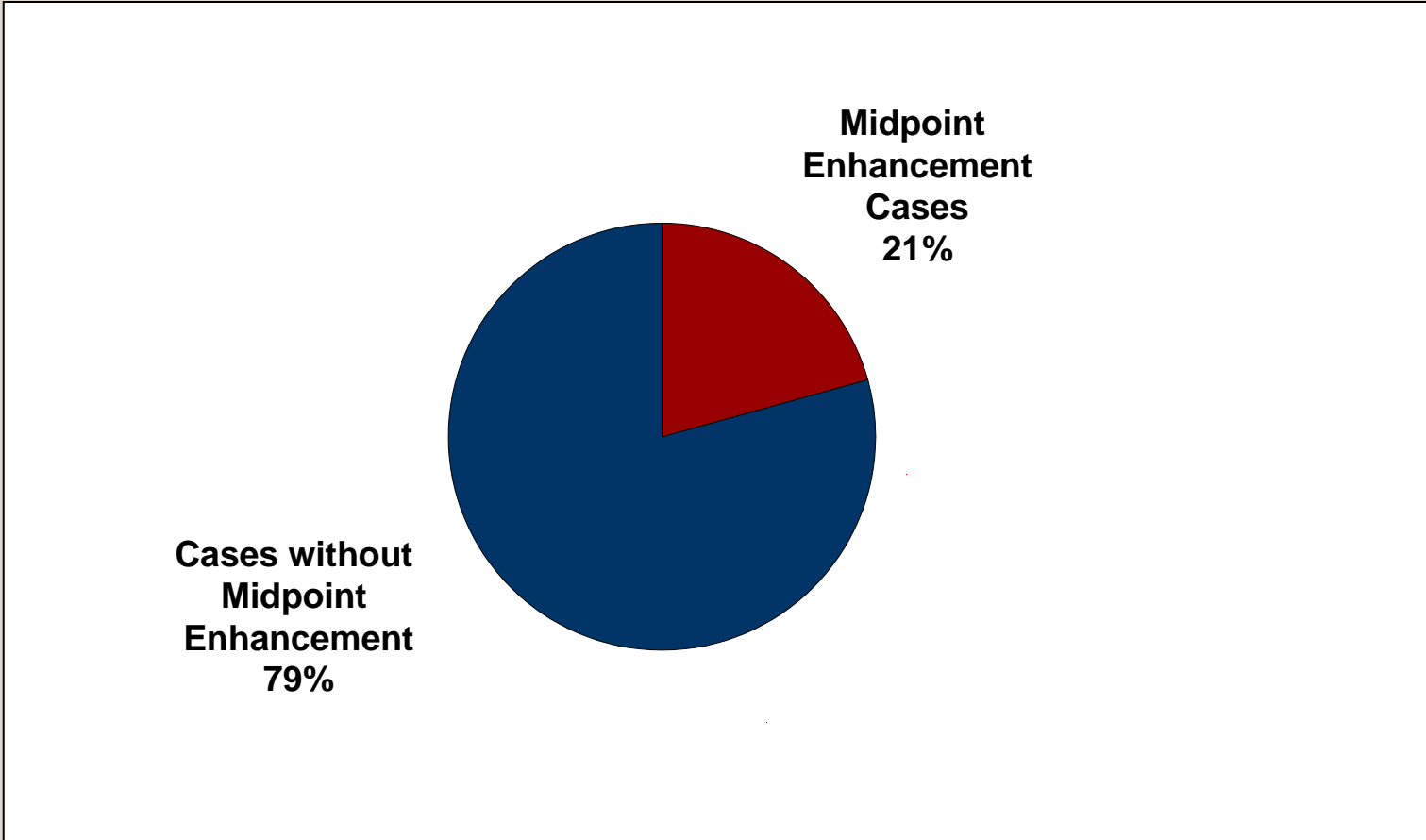
# Guidelines Compliance by Offense Category

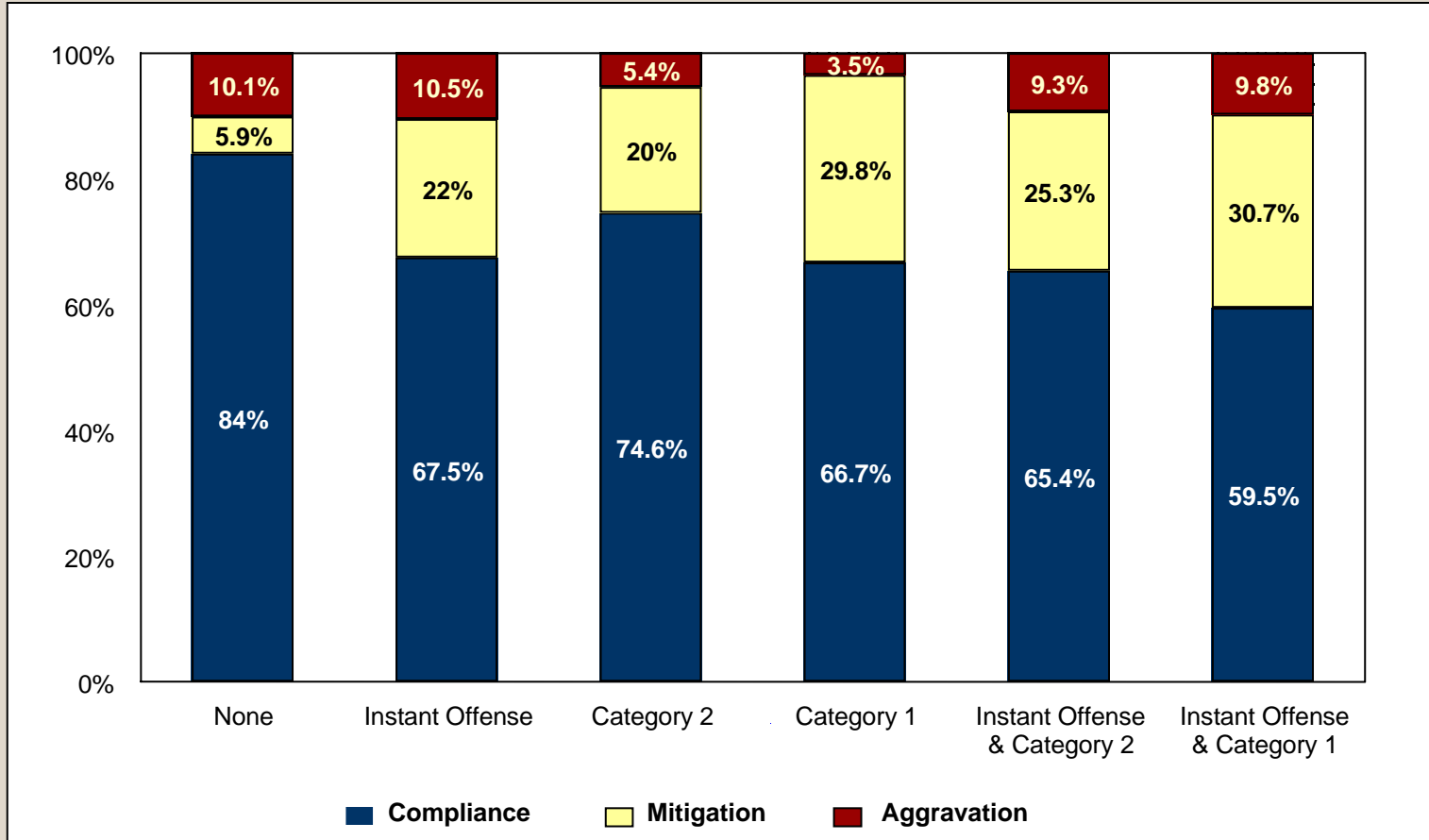
# Percentage of Midpoint Enhancement Cases

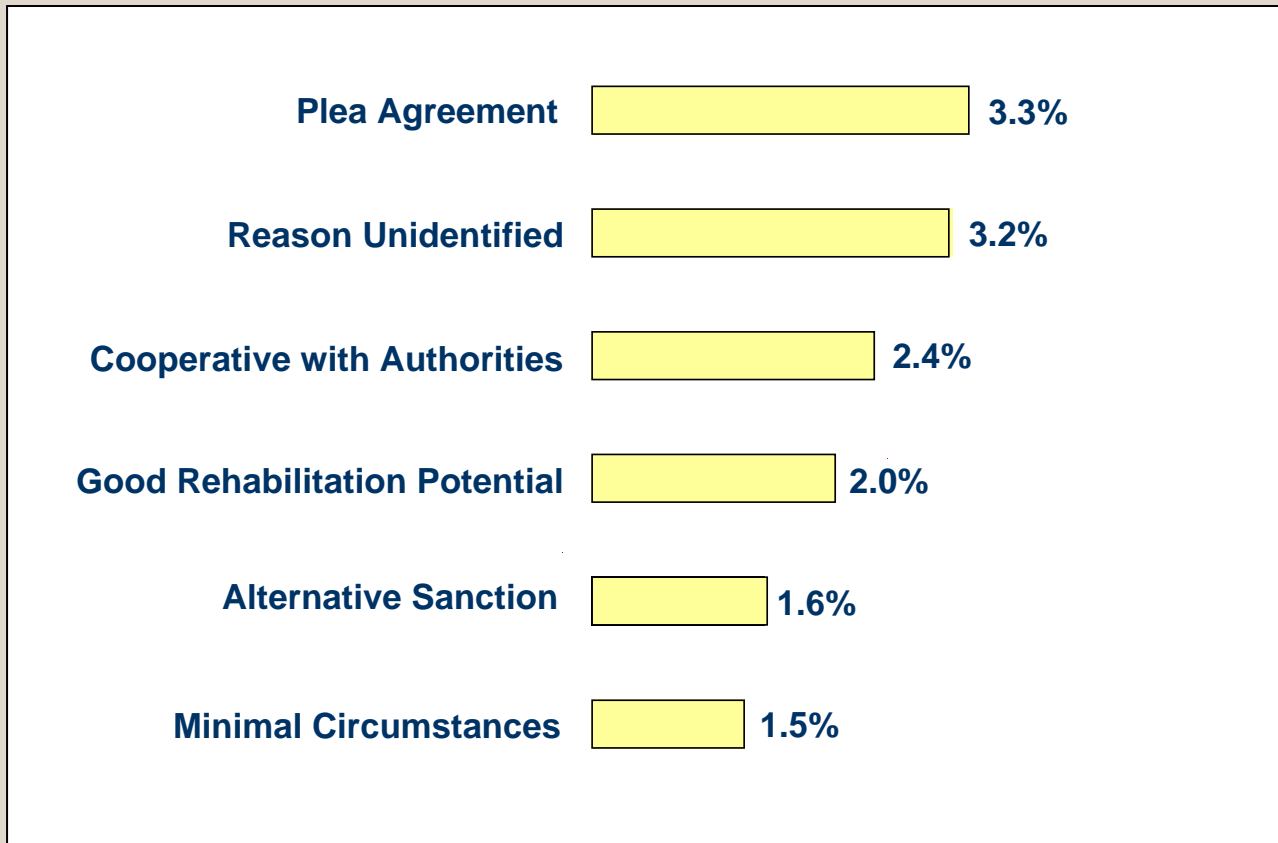

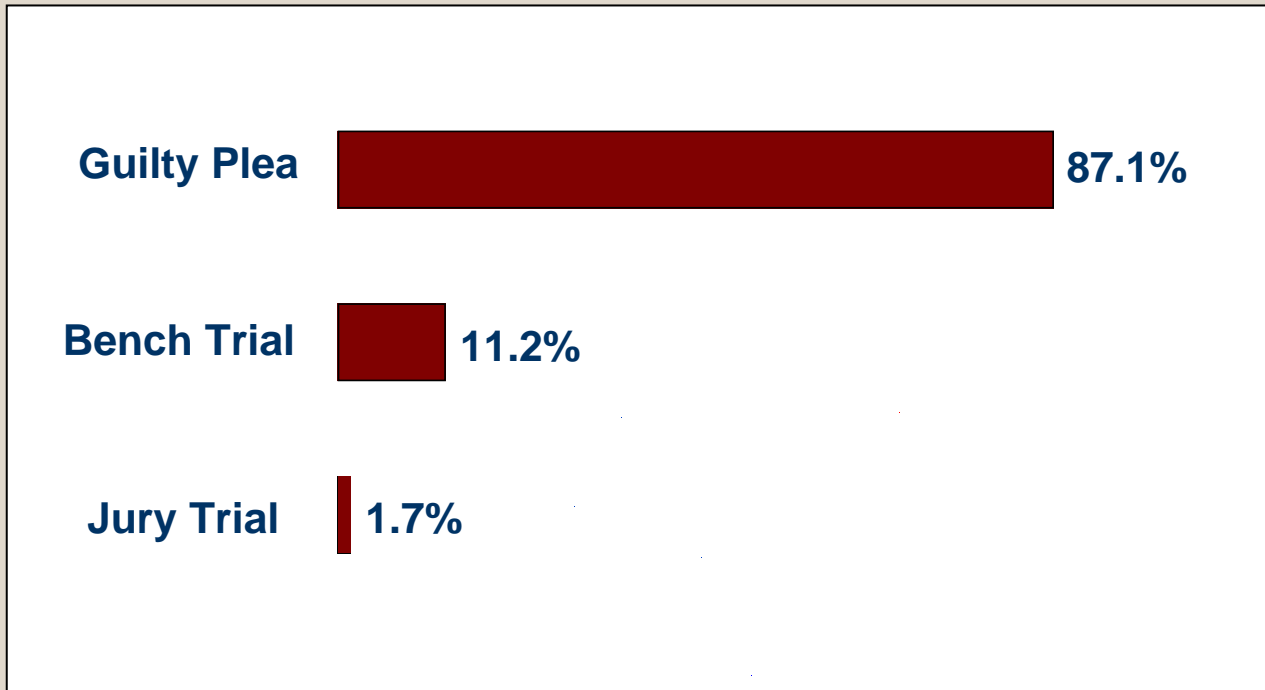
# Most Common Reasons for Mitigation in Midpoint Enhancement Cases

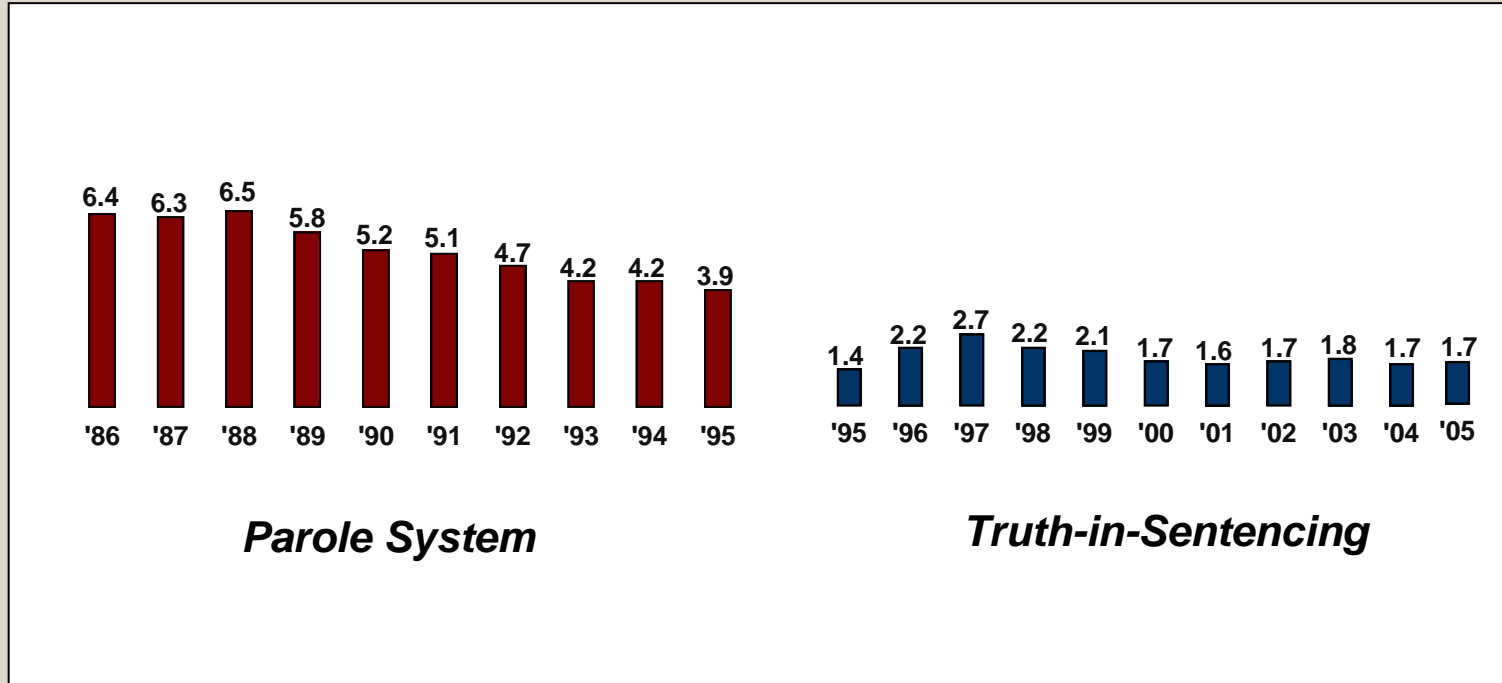

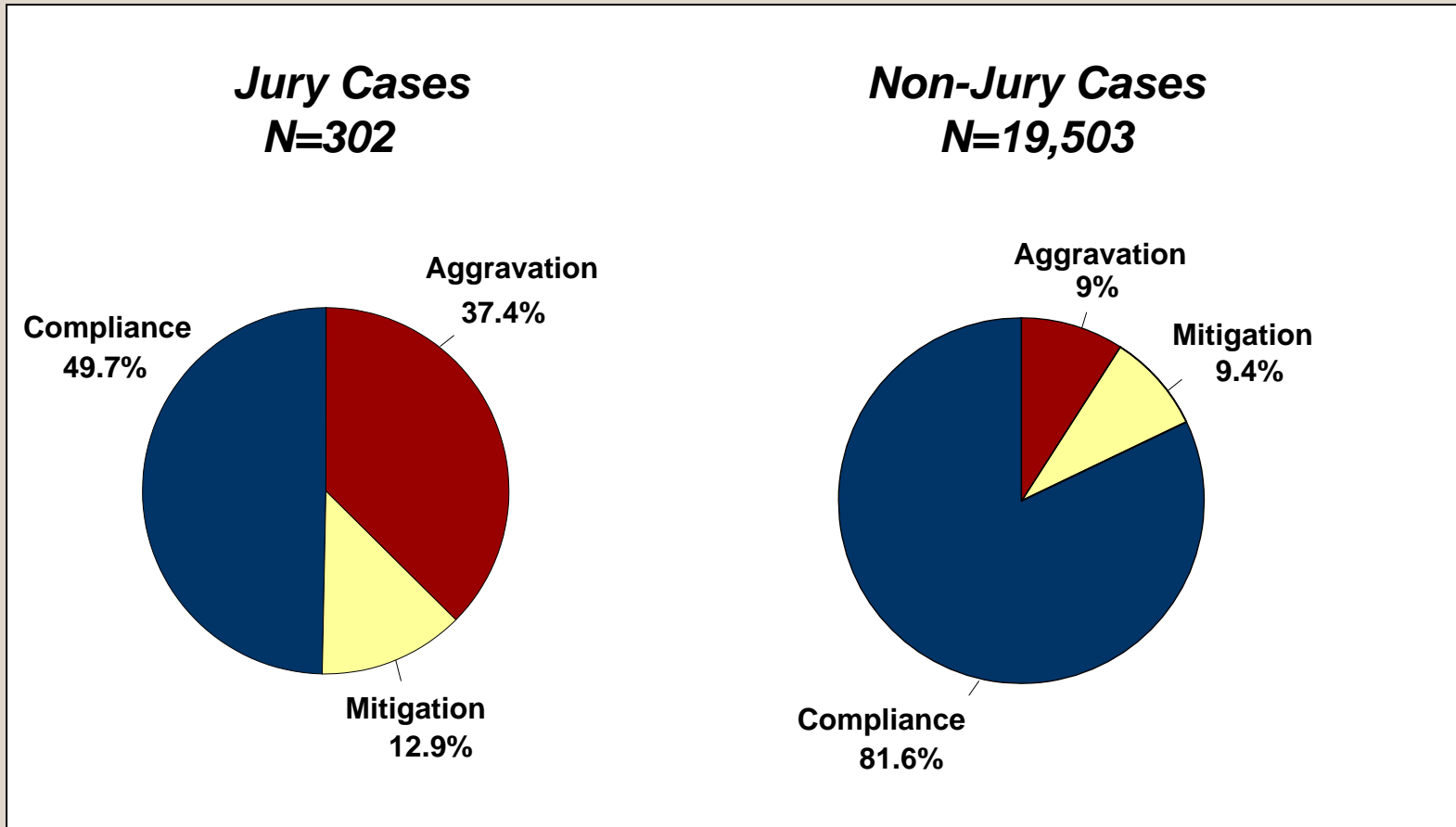
# Percent of Felony Convictions Adjudicated by Juries Parole v. Truth-in-Sentencing System

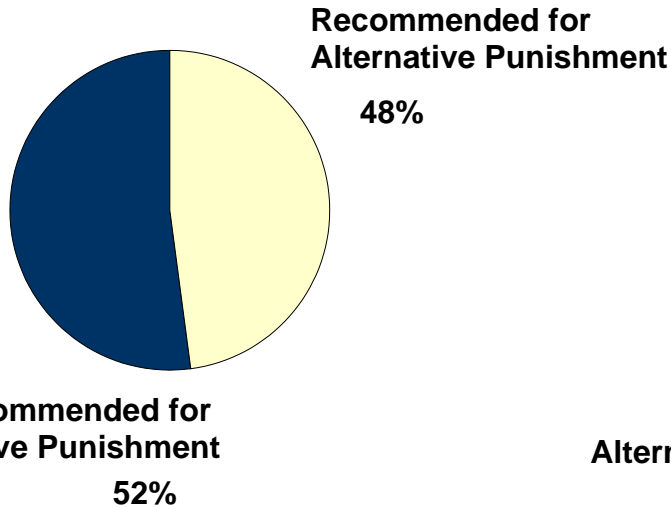

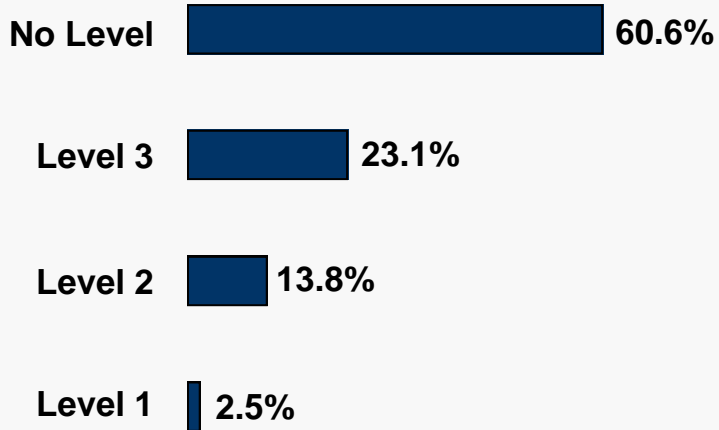

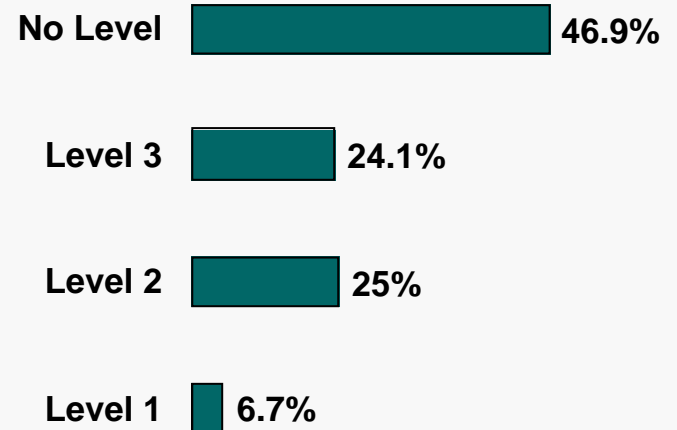

# Sex Offender Risk Levels

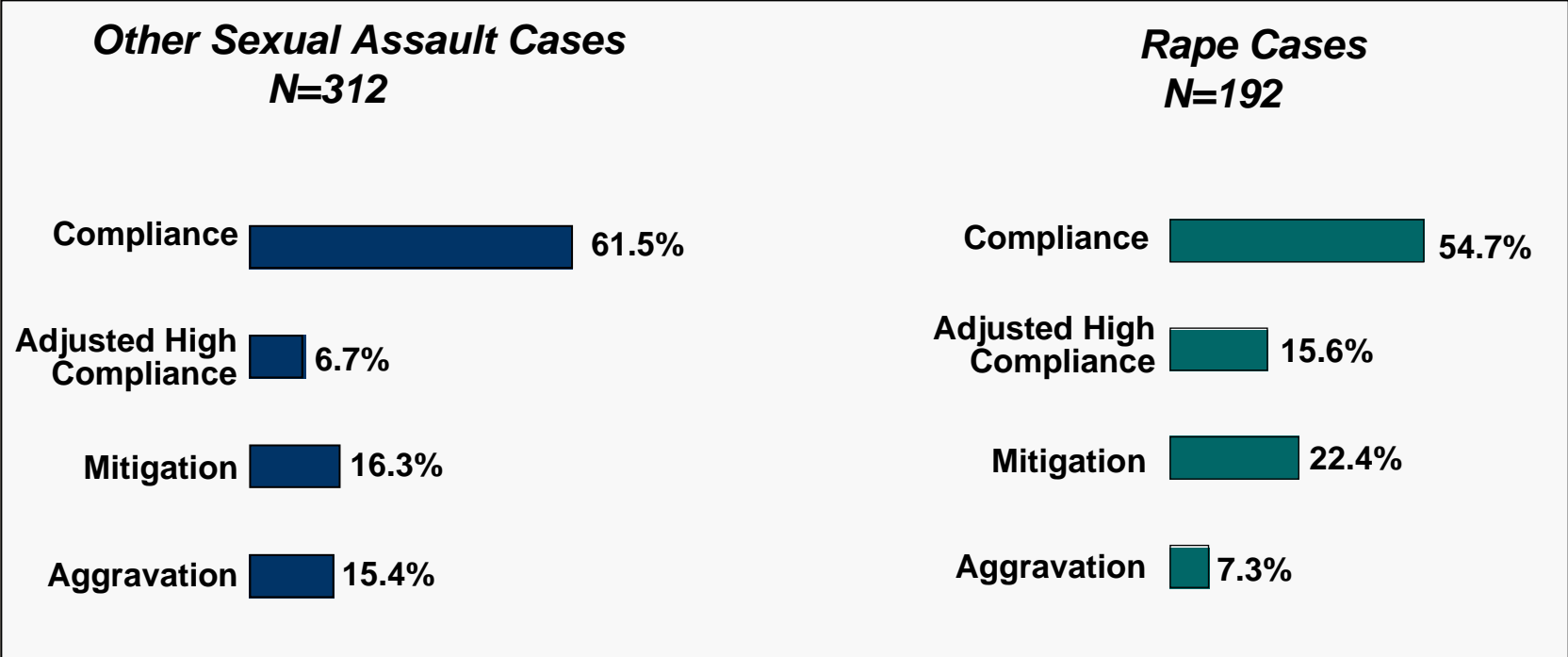
