Virginia's Sentencing Guidelines



Changes to Virginia's Sentencing Guidelines*

Effective July 1, 2018

- 1 Policy change for Probation Violations sentenced at the same time with a new felony offense.
- 2 ***SWIFT!***
- 3 Legislative change for larceny related crimes committed July 1, 2018 or after.
- 4 Three new offenses are covered by guidelines for any defendant sentenced on or after July 1, 2018.
- 5 Revised scores on the Kidnapping and Burglary Worksheets.

Policy Change for Probation Violations sentenced at the same time with a new felony offense.

Policy Change

Probation Violations will no longer be scored as additional offenses when sentenced at the same time with a felony guidelines offense. Cases may be sentenced in the same event, but the guidelines will reflect the recommendation for the new offense(s) and there will be no recommendation for the probation violation. The court must receive both the sentencing guidelines for the new felony offense and the sentencing revocation report. Both forms must be submitted to the Sentencing Commission.

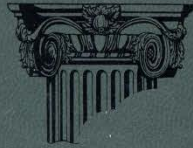

The New Generation of Sentencing Guidelines Worksheets



Beginning July 1, 2018, the Official Guidelines must be completed using *SWIFT!*

- The Sentencing Worksheet Interactive File Transfer (*SWIFT!*) is a web-based application designed for automating the sentencing guidelines. The application will allow users to complete the guidelines forms online, give users the ability to save guidelines information and recall it later. In the future, *SWIFT!* will provide a way for users to submit the guidelines to the court electronically, and permit the Clerk's to send the guidelines forms to the Commission in electronic format.

Legislative change for larceny related crimes committed July 1, 2018 or after.



Legislative Change: Change to Threshold for Grand Larceny

- Effective for crimes committed July 1, 2018 and after, the threshold for Grand Larceny increases from \$200 to \$500.
- The immediate impact on sentencing guidelines factors is that prior record factors are based on Virginia's current penalty structure.
- When preparers are unsure if the prior felony offense involved \$500 or more in property loss or damage, the prior conviction must be scored as a misdemeanor.
- The amount of restitution ordered or another measure authorized by the court may be used to determine if a prior felony was for property loss or damage of \$500 or more.
