INTRODUCTION TO SENTENCING GUIDELINES \$125

FOCUS ON PROBATION VIOLATION GUIDELINES \$60

(3 Hours-Approved for 3 CLE & VIDC Re-certification)

The probation violation seminar is designed for the attorney or criminal justice professional who is interested in learning more about the probation violation guidelines. The seminar will begin with general background information and progress to detailed information on scoring each of the guidelines factors. This seminar will address changes to §§ 19.2-306 and 19.2-306.1. You do not need to attend the Introduction seminar first. *Cost \$60.00 (Paralegals \$30).

SENTENCING GUIDELINES KNOWLEDGE & SKILLS \$80

(4 Hours-Approved for 4 CLE & VIDC Re-certification)

Participants are encouraged to attend the Introduction to Sentencing Guidelines seminar or have substantial experience completing Virginia's Sentencing Guidelines prior to enrolling in this seminar. This session is a participatory workshop that requires active engagement and the use of critical thinking skills to address complex sentencing guidelines issues. At the beginning of the seminar, participants will complete a questionnaire to help determine the specific topics covered in the Sentencing Guidelines Knowledge and Skills Seminar. *Cost \$80.00 (Paralegals \$40).

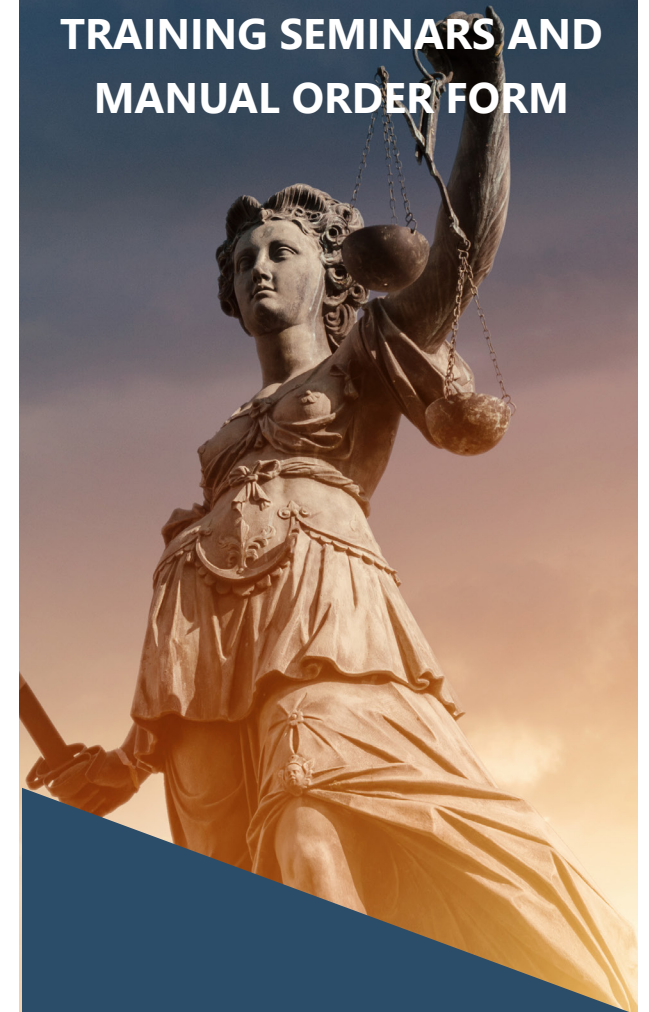
